

Jane Avril's snake

Toulouse Lautrec painted a dancer called Jane Avril wearing a special dress, decorated with a long, 3D (pretend) snake.

The artist used bright colours such as red, yellow and blue.

Create your picture using paint or use felt pens.

What you will need:

- pencil, crayon, thickest paper you can find, paints - watercolours or poster paint or, felt pens.



How to do it:

- Draw a long snake in pencil, with loops and curves.
- Draw extra curvy lines around your snake to make interesting shapes and fill up the page.
- Go over your lines with a crayon, this will help you to paint each section.
- Paint the snake one colour.
- Choose 2 or 3 colours to paint all the sections in the background.
- Dazzle the family with your drawing and painting in bright colours!
