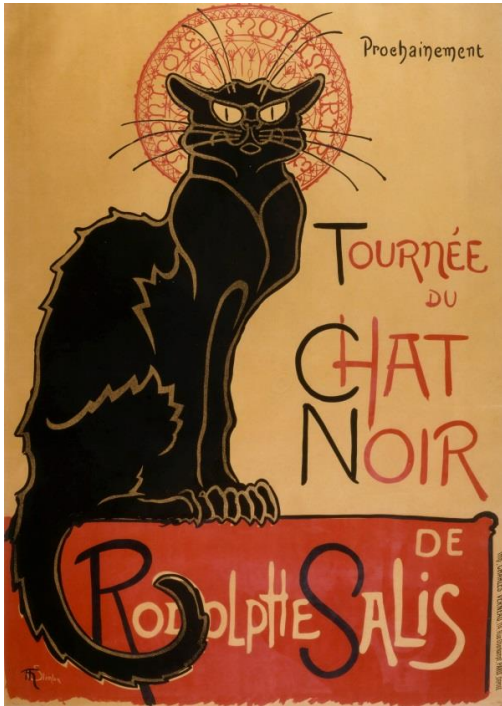


Print with Polystyrene



Toulouse Lautrec and his friends printed beautiful posters in Paris in the 1890s. You can recycle polystyrene from pizza packaging to make a printing block.

You will need:

Polystyrene pizza packaging or Safeprint foam, scissors, pencil or biro, paper, poster paint and medium size brush or small roller

- **Ask an adult for help** to cut the thin polystyrene into a rectangle with scissors.
- Draw lightly onto the surface using a pencil or biro, keep it simple!
- Go over your drawing with the point of the pencil or biro, pressing into the surface, so you can feel the groove with your fingers.
- Use a small roller or a paintbrush to spread poster paint thinly over the printing block you have made.
- Turn the painted block over carefully onto a piece of paper and rub the back firmly.
- Lift up the block carefully to reveal your print. Have fun experimenting with different colours!
